The Pavilion dv9000t, which debuted last fall as a Windows XP-based machine, is one of the few laptops capable of displaying HD DVD movies in high definition, either on its 17-inch WXGA screen, or on an HDTV connected to an integrated HDMI laptop port. With the exception of its switch on Windows Vista Ultimate, this latest iteration of the dv9000t remains largely unchanged. It comes with everything you need to replace a desktop PC: good entertainment features; Plenty of speed and a well-designed keyboard, screen and body. To accommodate the latest peripherals, the laptop offers four USB ports, one FireWire port and an ExpressCard slot. At 7.7 pounds, the dv9000t in portable weight is mid-road: not ideal for frequent trips, but easier to move from room to room than some desktop replacements. You can also participate in video chatting with friends online through an additional integrated webcam. The only option of entertainment not available at the click of a button is television, but the device is fully equipped to support this feature Windows Media Center with the help of digital/similar TV tuner ExpressCard, remote control and coaxial adapter. A hybrid analog-digital desktop antenna allows you to receive local signals when a cable connection is not possible. dv9000t is fast enough and powerful enough to handle any application. Our review unit 2-GHz Core 2 Duo T7200 chip, 2GB of RAM, and 120GB hard drive helped it earn WorldBench 6 Beta Score 74 - three points above the team's average desktop replacement group 71.Thanks to its 256MB nVidia GeForce Go 7600 graphics controller, dv9000t held its own in our tests, playing playing playing Frame rate. He performed best in our Far Cry test with a resolution of 1024 at 768 (79 frames per second), but was fast enough in all tests to prove himself a solid gamer. The HP X360 Pavilion is a budget priced 2-in-1 laptop that hasn't delayed budget performance. In fact, it's the fastest low-cost hybrid we've ever tested. Other highlights include a sturdy, eye-catching design, a good keyboard and a good battery life. And while its 11.6-inch display is cramped and its design is a bit on the heavy side, the Pavilion x360 is still an obvious choice for workers who want a portable hybrid laptop for on-the-go performance. For more information on how we test mobile devices, visit our Design x360 is far from the most travel-friendly device in its category. The laptop weighs a relatively hefty 3.2 pounds and measures 12.05 x 8.19 x 0.89 inches, making it heavier, bigger and thicker than competition. Dell's Inspiron 11 3000, by comparison, weighs 3.1 pounds and measures less than 11.8 x 7.9 x 0.74 inches. The Lenovo Flex 3 11 is an even lighter option for passengers weighing just 3 pounds, with a mid-road measurement of 11.8 x 8.2 x 0.86 inches. I'm a big fan of the x360 beautiful silver lid, and the matte plastic interior looks understated and professional. I also like the sturdy hinge of the laptop that stays in place when you fold the device into different positions. The multiple modes that separates the X360 from the mid-budget laptop is a flexible hinge that allows you to flip the display around a full 360 degrees to use the device as a tablet. If this seems gimmicky for laptop, you may be surprised at how useful the hybrid design really is. Tablet mode is good for using touch-optimized apps on the go, but the X360 is a bit heavy to carry around pills for a long time. Perhaps even more useful are the tents and booth modes, both of which include folding the partway display, allowing you to maintain a touchscreen on a flat surface. Both can be useful for sharing presentations for a small group, and stand mode in particular is good for using the machine in cramped spaces such as on the plane tray table. The x360 hinge is good and sturdy, so you can comfortably tap on the display in any mode without the machine collapsing on your desk. Display For some workers, the x360's cramped 11.6-inch display can be a deal breaker. I found the small, 1366 x 786-pixel screen convenient for basic performance tasks, but it felt cramped for split-screen multitasking, or other screen-intensive tasks such as viewing large documents and editing spreadsheets. The 11.6-inch display is surrounded by an unusually thick bezel, making it even smaller. The x360 display is also lackluster than average, topping 227 nits of brightness in the brightest setting, which is below the 234-nit average. It's still good for indoor use, but a brighter screen would be better for using the device outdoors or in direct sunlight. Keyboard and touchpad While most 11-inch laptops offer abbreviated keyboards that are too cramped for a serious typing, the X360 has a frame that is large enough to accommodate a full-size keyboard. The keys are well uncoupled and offer quick reviews. And with key travel measurements of about 1.5mm - roughly the average among laptops - you get a pretty handy typing experience overall. The touchpad is relatively small, measuring about 3.75 x 2.2 inches, compared to the Inspiron 11's 4.1 x 2.4-inch pad. But I still like the smooth matte finishing pad, which my finger easily slips. The cursor control feels accurate, and clicking on the pad for left and right clicks feels fast. Performance is hard to be productive on a sluggish machine, so budget laptops - most of which run on under-powerful Intel Pentium processors - have long been a hard sell for business users. That's what's so impressive about the X360 Pavilion: this is the first budget 2-in-1 laptop we tested that works on the new Intel Core M chip, making it the fastest low-priced hybrid I know. The X360 also beat all competitors in several other tests, including tests that measure hard drive speed and graphics One drawback is that the machine tends to run a little hot, especially on its underside. That's because its Core M processor doesn't use fan cooling. This is hardly a deal breaker, but the heat issue is something to keep in mind if you plan to use x360 on your lap very often. The battery life of the Pavilion x360 in battery life is pretty good, but not impressive, running for 6 hours and 28 minutes on our battery life test, which simulates continuous browsing of web pages over Wi-Fi. That's roughly on par with the budget 2-in-1 category average of 6 hours and 26 minutes. When used mixed, the x360 should last long enough to get you through the average working day, but it is far from the longest device of its kind. The Dell Inspiron 11 3000 lasted a little longer (6 hours and 42 minutes), but it is the Acer Aspire Switch 10 E that the real battery champion in this category runs for an epic 8 hours and 28 minutes. This is something to consider if you need a device that can last through long business flights without recharging. The ports x360's port choice is more generous than your average 11-inch laptop. The right edge of the laptop is two USB 3.0 ports, a full-size HDMI port and an Ethernet port to connect to wired Internet and office networks. The left side of the laptop, meanwhile, has one USB 2.0 port, an SD card reader to expand internal storage, and a secure lock slot for the physical protection of the device on your desk. Windows hybrid software like pavilion x360s feel much more practical since the recent launch of Windows 10, the latest version of Microsoft's desktop operating system. The fresh OS, which comes installed on this machine, offers separate laptops and tablet modes. The laptop mode has a familiar Windows desktop interface, while tablet mode offers a more touch-based setup that will be familiar to Android and iPad users, with full-screen apps and light navigation buttons at the bottom of the screen. You can switch between modes manually, or x360 switch automatically when you fold the screen back. Several useful performance apps also come pre-loaded on x360, including Evernote for taking and saving notes, and Skype for major video conferencing. The HP Connected Drive app, meanwhile, makes it easy to transfer large files to 100MB on 10 computers. Finally, the Dropbox cloud storage app comes with 25GB of free storage for six months. The X360 delivers top-notch performance and solid design on the cheap. This is the fastest 2-in-1 hybrid under \$500 that I know makes it a good option for serious performance. Its flexible hinge is actually useful rather than a gimmick, and its keyboard is solid. On the other hand, relative machine, and the tendency to run a little hot, keep it from perfection. The 11.6-inch Dell Inspiron 11 3000 is a great alternative for workers with only basic computing needs. It is a more portable satellite with longer battery life and a brighter, brighter, bright display, although its Pentium processor is a little under-rendy.
